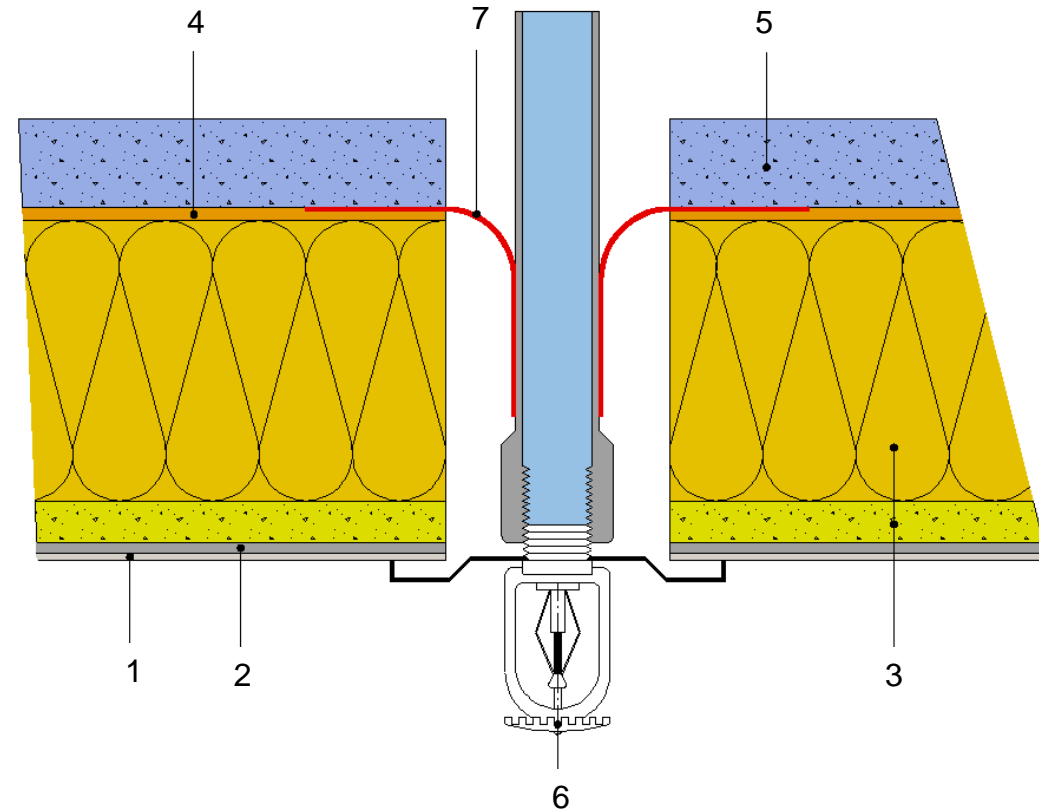


Important:

Any and all penetrations of installations, as well as gaps for connections to building elements, must be sealed with vapour barrier adhesive tape before the application of the acoustic panels. Such seals prevent air circulation through the open-pore acoustic system (prevention of partial dust deposits in the top coat).
